CURRENT SITUATION

- In the past Bach blamed WADA for chaos, now he blames CAS (incl. IOC Members) IOC president calls the CAS decision "extremely disappointing and surprising.""We would never have expected this,"
- All athletes are confused and enraged, even the Russians are, because Bach called ...
- ... "Olympic Athletes from Russia" new and clean generation of athletes now they are maybe send home during the Olympics.
- Instead of solving the crisis Bach complains about "cartel rulings" and stronger "individual rights" for athletes worldwide.
- 10C has refused a request for 15 Russian athletes and coaches "cleared of doping" to attend the PyeongChang Games.
- At least 168 Russian athletes are participating in the Games, according to the PyeongChang official website.
- 45 Russian athletes will not take part in the Olympics after the CAS dismissed their request to be invited. Yesterday 13 athletes were denied access.
- Meanwhile Sunday Times /ARD claim it has seen evidence that suggests widespread blood doping in endurance skiing events between 2001 and 2010.
